

Voting with a Touchscreen Ballot on the ClearAccess™ system

Contest Screen

Touch [Settings](#) for Magnification, Color/Contrast, Audio ballot playback, and Visual Ballot Display

Touch the box to the left of the candidate's name to make a selection, touch again to deselct your choice

Touch the box to the left of the [Write-In](#) option to prompt the Write-In Screen

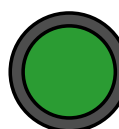

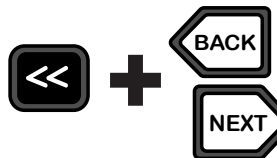
The Shift Key



The shift key changes button behaviors when pressed at the same time as the following:



Increases/decreases volume



Increases/decreases speech playback rate



Pauses/resumes speech playback



Skips to the next sentence



Skips back to the previous sentence

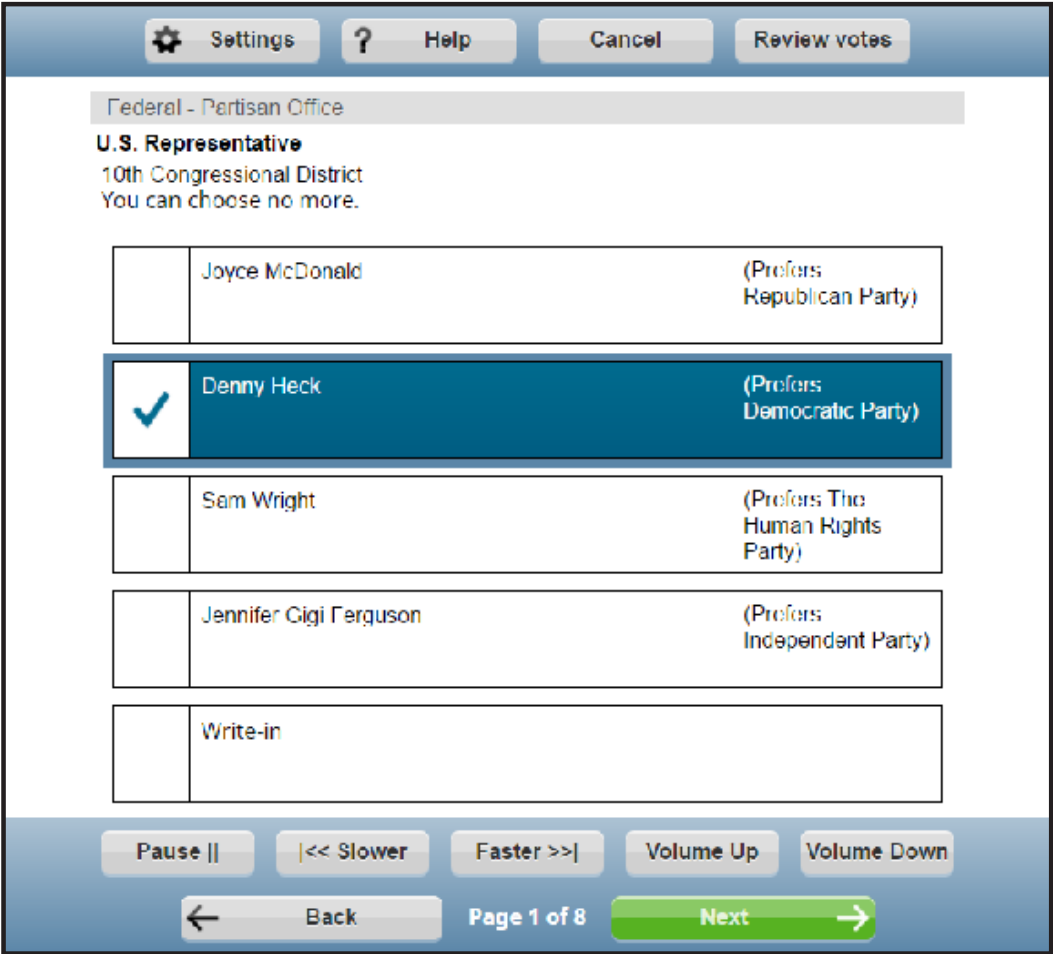

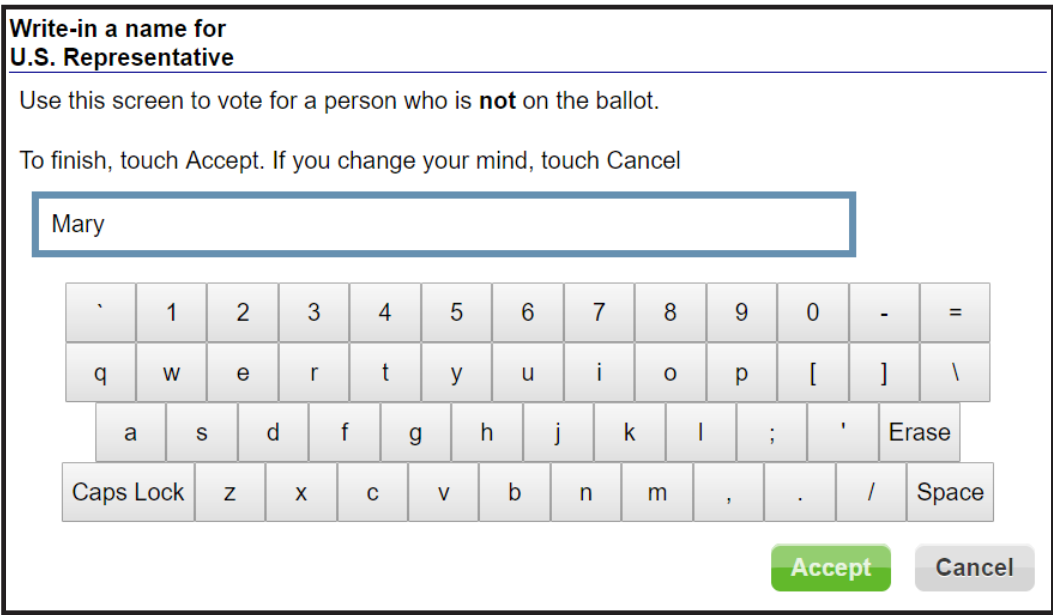
