Modifications to Election Law (HB0218)

This bill amends provisions of the Election Code. Enactment of this legislation likely will not materially impact state revenue. Enactment of this bill could cost the Governor's Office \$25,900 one-time from the General Fund in FY 2018 for programming costs to electronically process voter registration applications, automatically remove voters from the absentee mailing list, and modify the absentee voter list. It could also save the Driver License Division \$1,300 ongoing General Fund beginning in FY 2019 in avoided application processing costs.
