

Governor's website is for people who voted by mail so they can verify if the ballot they mailed or dropped in a box was received by the Election Division. When you voted in person, you signed in, reviewed your ballot on the machine and the paper trail, and then selected CAST BALLOT.

Perhaps you better read the information again.

The TRACK YOUR BALLOT tool doesn't say you voted by mail. It says "your county clerk mailed you a ballot," which we did. The message at the top is GENERIC and it is too let voters know that it might take a few days for us to process their ballot **IF THEY VOTED BY MAIL**. They didn't intend for voters who actually vote in person to try to *track their ballot*. TRACK YOUR BALLOT is for voters who use a by-mail ballot so they will know if we received the ballot they mailed or dropped in a drop box.

If you vote in person, there is no reason for you to track your ballot. You voted your ballot in person and were able to view the paper trail on the voting machine and then CAST YOUR BALLOT.

The Lt. Governor's website TRACK YOUR BALLOT tool does not display for those who voted in person. It is for the people who voted by mail so they can find out if their by-mail ballot was received when they mailed it or dropped it in a ballot box.

Ballots were mailed to all active registered voters, and that is their generic message.

When you vote in person, you sign in, review your ballot on the machine and the paper trail and then CAST BALLOT. That is the equivalent of you putting your ballot in the ballot box.

Election Night results included all the votes cast in person.

Hi Justin,

I am now answering emails regarding this newest Facebook rumor as [REDACTED] indicated below. I have not heard until now that there was any problem with ballots being counted that were dropped at the Magna Library for the 2016 General Elections.

As I explained before, voters are being confused by your TRACK MY BALLOT tool when it gives the message "No Ballot Found". They are not only using it to see if they are going to receive a ballot for the November Election, but are also trying to track their ballots from the previous elections. The voter below is unaffiliated and hasn't voted since 11/2019. I sent her a copy of her VISTA voter history screen so she could see that her ballots have been counted and explained that it was disabled for the last election after the July 17th certification. I also explained that it does not track ballots for past elections.

Will you please see if it is possible to have a different message added to this tool so voters don't continue being confused by it?

Below is the ballot order as recorded in the database for [REDACTED]. I tried to phone her and you, but didn't get an answer. Her ballot was mailed to her on October 13th. Also included below, is the mail-tracking on her ballot (ID [REDACTED]). It shows her ballot went "out for delivery" with the carrier on October 14th. It should have arrived that day. Please have her check and see if she received it (bright yellow envelope).

I cannot look up other voters for whom you think ballots should have been delivered without their specific information. In looking at all the registered voters at that address, I see about fourteen listed as "inactive," and that would mean they weren't sent a ballot. We cannot mail ballots to "inactive" voters in accordance with Utah State Law.

I took the time to check into each record for about 120 voters registered there. About a dozen have not returned their ballots yet. One person didn't include an apartment number on the registration form [REDACTED] so her ballot may not have been delivered to her.

We can email ballots to voters who need an ADA accomodation.
