

# Risk Limit Set for the 2020 Presidential Primary Election

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Updated March 5, 2020

On January 31, 2020, and in accordance with Election Rule 25.2.2 (a), the Secretary of State established a risk limit of 4% for the comparison risk-limiting audit (RLA) of the March 3, 2020 Presidential Primary Election. On March 5, 2020, due to wide margins in the statewide contests, the Secretary of State has exercised her discretion and decreased the risk limit to 1%.

### Comparison audits

The risk limit for comparison audits is 1%. The following counties will conduct comparison audits following the 2020 Presidential Primary Election:
