And BS 68 has City of Hutto races on it (see attached pdf of BS 68).

Holly, maybe you covered this already in training. **But I think it's important that we stress that check-in clerks verify that the BS printed on the ballot card matches what's on the TouchPad screen.** Because if there was some kind of mishap with the previous voter at that station, it might be possible that the BS for them is repeated for the next voter. I have to wonder how many voters are voting an incorrect ballot like Kim did, if their actual BS style on the card wasn't verified.
