Thank you for the news article. There is no way we can accommodate 22% of the voters at vote centers.

Our message on our ballot packet instructions says that in-person vote centers are for the voters who need them because they did not receive a by-mail ballot, or misplaced their ballot. We are using the example that only 20 people in line, with 6 ft social distancing, would mean the line will be 120 feet long.

We desperately need help from the State to get the message to voters that our voting system is vote-by-mail and that it is safe and secure. We no longer have traditional poll places and we are not equipped to offer them. This isn't a situation where, in the midst of the pandemic, voters should be opting to vote by whichever method they want.

Our poll workers have bravely volunteered to serve and it is not fair for them to be unnecessarily exposed to more people who do not need to be at the vote centers.

I'm pretty sure the registration date is whenever the form was submitted, but the mail date is probably closer to when the form was processed. Vote ID is [REDACTED]. This voters registration date is marked as 02/24/2020, but the form was mailed on March 30, 2020. The [REDACTED] campaign is concerned about the lag time between the two dates.

Thanks for this explanation.

I think we're going to need to get more information regarding dates of registration and dates of review, then. Attached is a picture of [REDACTED]'s voter registration card which she just got in the mail. It shows the registration date as 2/24. We did not turn in signatures until 3/10, so it could not have been reviewed before she was registered. However, it does show the mailing date of the document as 3/30.

We are concerned about these type of examples that we don't have the paper trail but clearly there's an error because of the processing delays.
