National Election Pool

The **National Election Pool (NEP)** is a polling consortium that comprises the following news organizations: [ABC](#), [CBS](#), [CNN](#), and [NBC](#). The NEP was started in 2003 to "[pool] together resources to gather vote and exit poll data."^{[1][2]}

Edison Research, a media research and polling firm, conducts all exit polling on behalf of the NEP.^[3]

According to Edison Research Executive Vice President Joe Lenski, the networks that form the NEP "control the editorial and financial decisions, in terms of how to allocate resources and what questions to ask. ... They have committees that write the questionnaires. They have committees that decide which primaries or caucuses are covered, how many precincts are covered."^[4]

Fox News and the Associated Press were members of the NEP until 2017.^{[5][6]}
