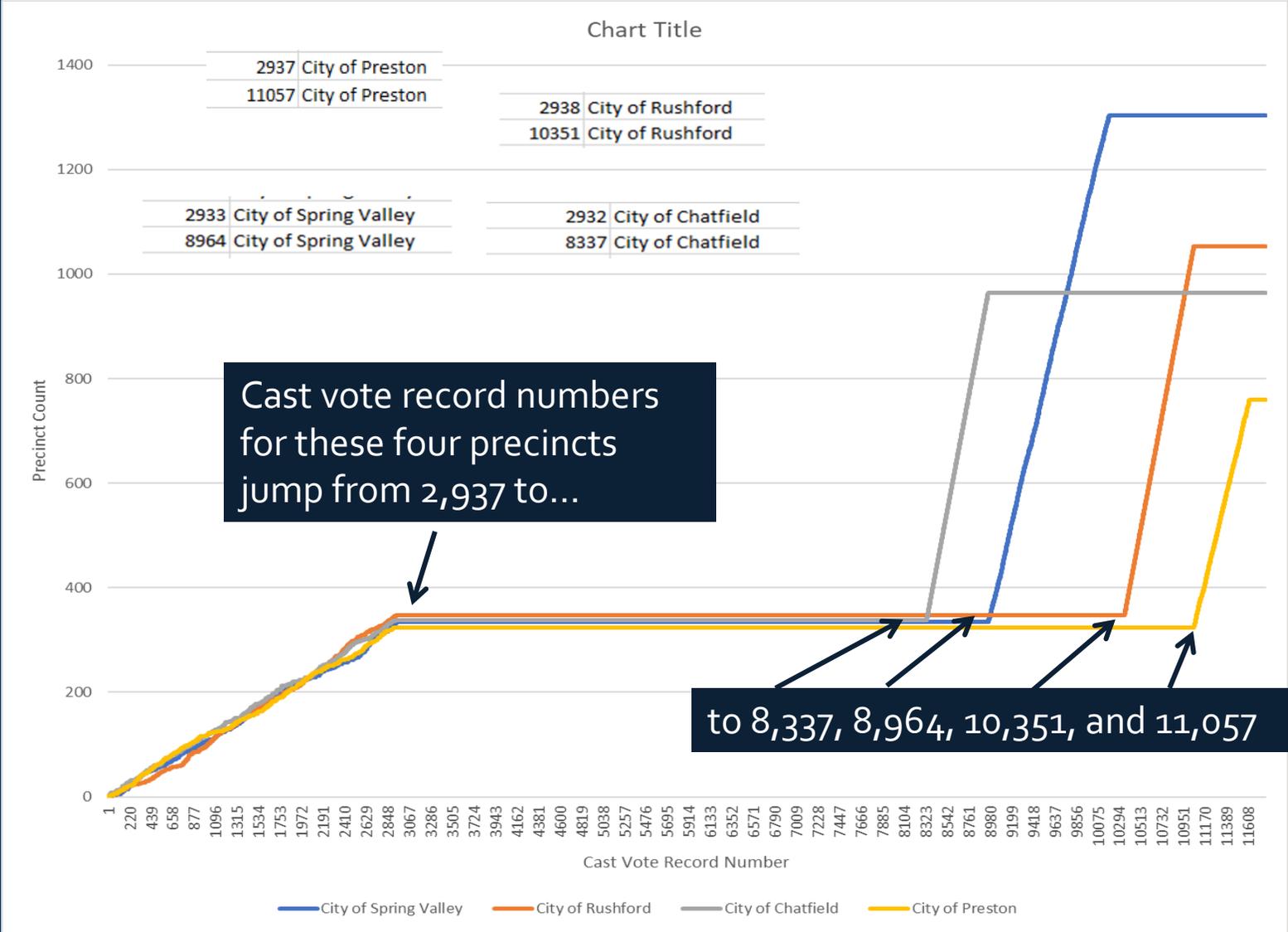

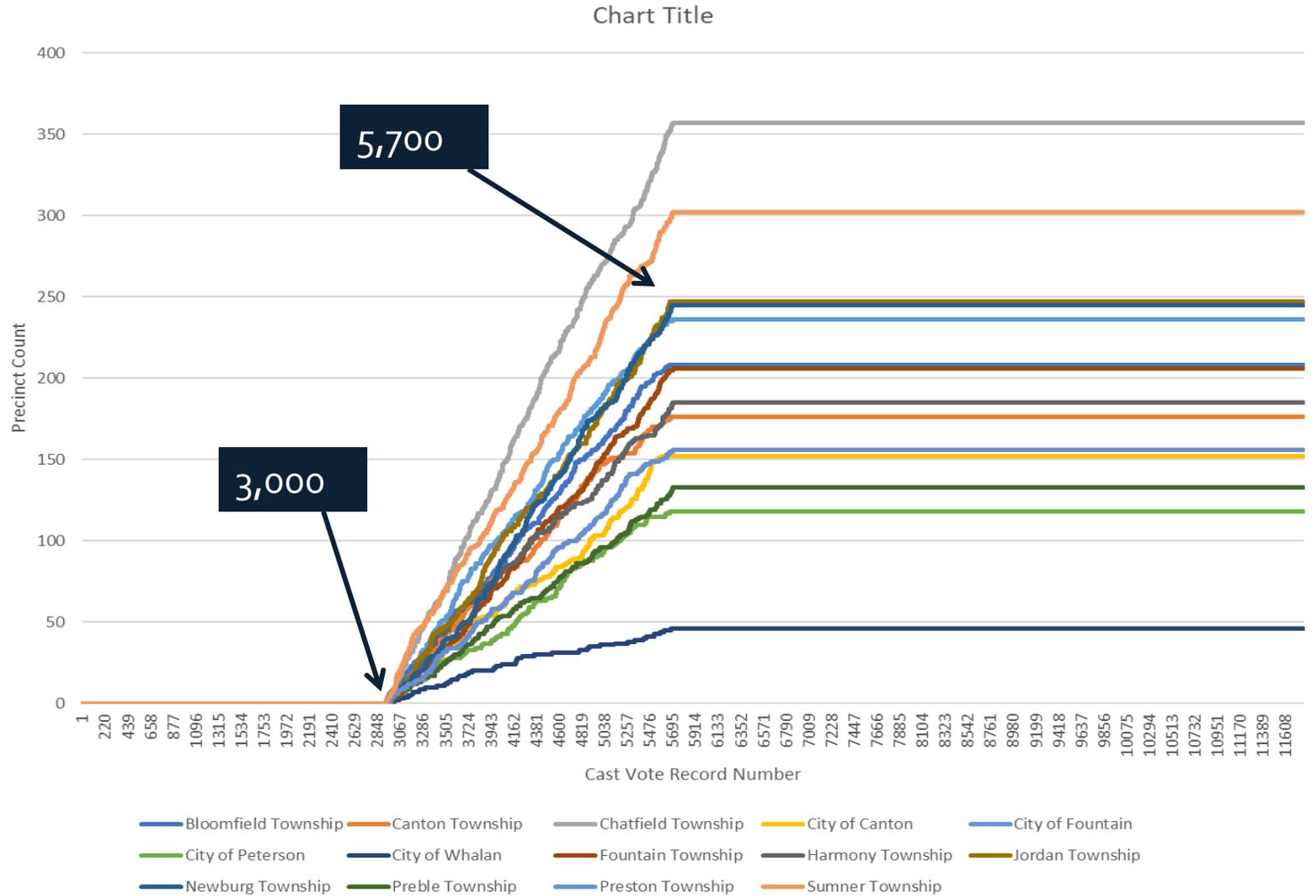
CVR numbers skip in largest precincts



Precincts not processed in batches

These precincts have CVR numbers from 3,000 to 5,700.

These precincts were not processed in batches like the rest of the precincts.

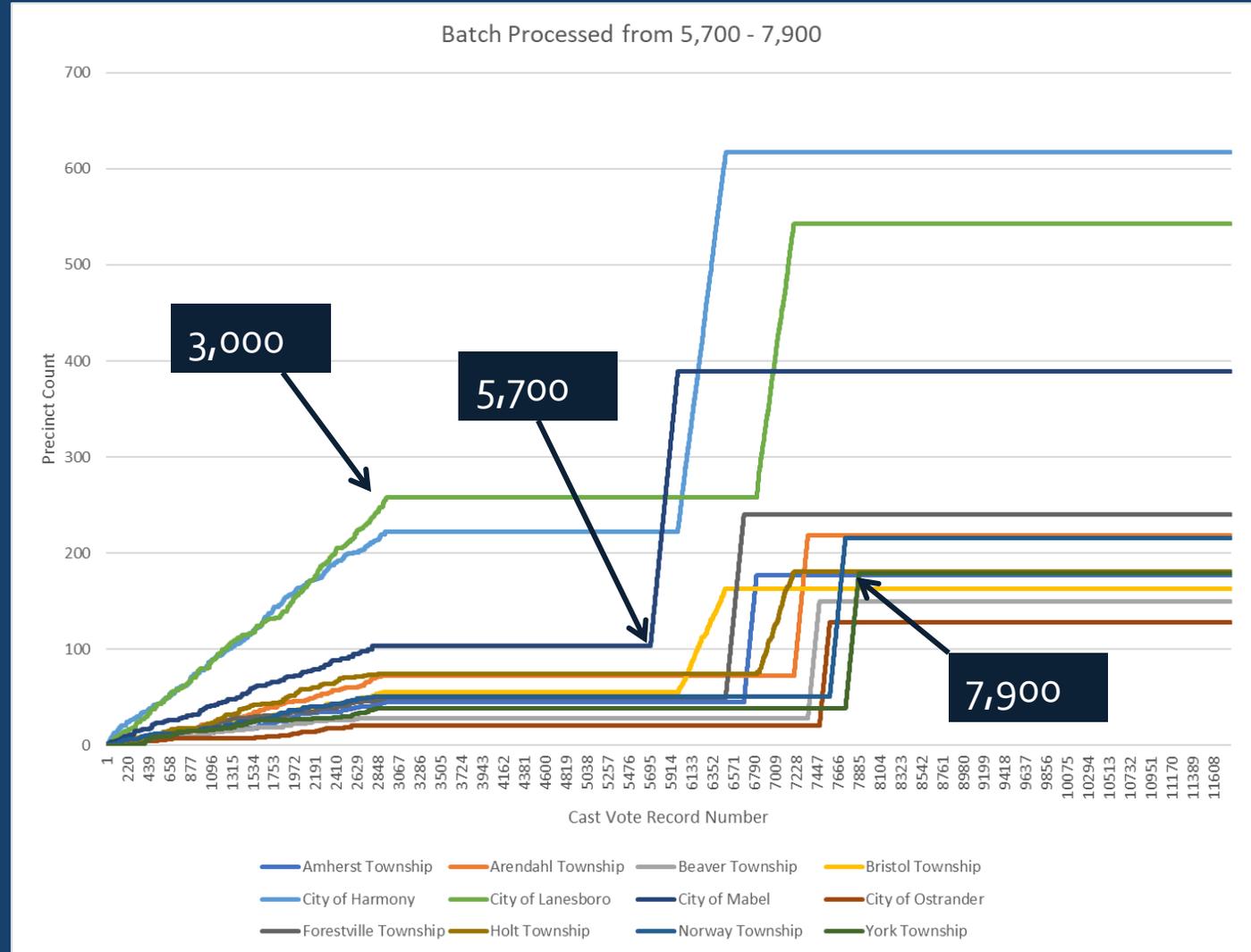


These precincts were batch processed

These are the first precincts that were processed in batches.

Their votes were processed continuously along with 3,000 other votes.

Then they were processed in batches and assigned CVR numbers from 5,700 to 7,900.

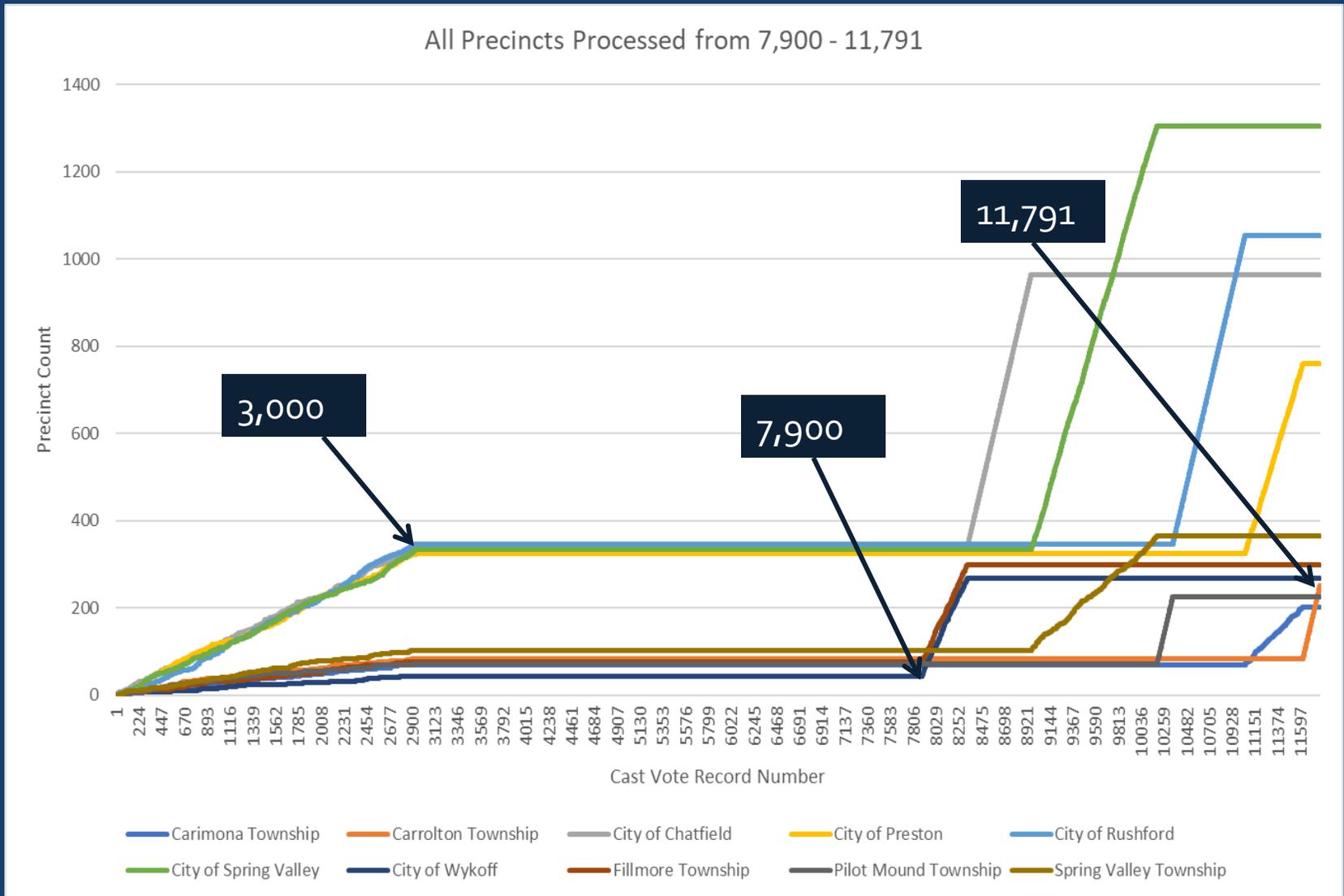


Precincts processed last

These were the last precincts to be processed. It contains the four largest precincts in the county.

The first ballots were processed continuously with 3,000 other votes.

The batches were processed last and assigned CVR numbers from 7,900 – 11,791.



What explains the identical graphs

- CVR numbers indicate ballots were processed in precinct batches
- CVR numbers do not reflect time
- It cannot be the case that the trendlines were driven by one party voting early and another party late
- The question remains how five races can have such similar voting patterns
