

1.3.5 Withdrawing or restoring contests or candidates

To withdraw or restore contests or candidates in an election:

1. Access the [Election Administration](#) page in ClearCount and locate the election you want to modify.
2. Click the button in the Actions column for that election and select **Withdrawn Contests/Choices** from the drop-down list that appears. The Withdrawn Contests and Choices page for the election replaces the Election Administration page in the browser tab.

 Nonadministrative users can view this page, but cannot change selections.
