



There is a canvassing project that is being organized in all 72 Counties in Wisconsin. There are 45 States across the USA that have also been participating, and the number of states continues to grow.

Have you attended an event or heard of Dr. Douglas Frank or Mike Lindell? They and other people have assisted in organizing this project.

Most of us already know about the voter roll issues and some have worked on identifying issues with their local voter rolls in the past.

This canvass project will be taking it a few steps further.

Teams of canvassers will be provided walk-book lists of addresses that meet certain criteria and likely have issues. In-person visits to those addresses and interviews with the residents will be conducted, simply to verify information about the registered voters at that address.

Each walk-book list will take about 2 hours. Some counties have 5 walk-book lists, while counties with larger populations may have up to 74 walk-book lists to complete. We would like to aim for a March completion date.

There is Zoom training provided and various forms to document the findings. The training takes about an hour and a half and will be provided via a zoom power point presentation.

The information collected will be given to the Clerks and Sheriffs of each County. Then the North of 29 Movement, an election integrity group, will present the information to an attorney and others assisting them, and will most likely present this information with the intent that it may be used as evidence in potential court cases.

There have been dramatic findings in other states with this process and the initial findings so far in Wisconsin confirm there are major problems with our voter rolls.

Some examples: One bedroom trailer house with 20 registered voters, summer youth camp with 40 registered voters, a seasonal campground with over 100 registered voters, Dollar General Stores with registered voters, and it goes on and on.

On the ground reports from canvassers in every County are that the vast majority of people contacted for a canvass interview, are very receptive, and are glad to see the non-partisan efforts being made to clean up the voter rolls in Wisconsin.

It does not matter if people are liberal, conservative, or somewhere in the middle, everyone wants honest elections.

Volunteers and Team Leaders for each County are needed to help with this very important canvassing project. Please consider being a part of the movement to restore honest, open, transparent and accurate elections in Wisconsin and our nation.
